Caught between the Severn and Wye, the forest has a distinctive landscape and identity. Historically annexed as a Royal Forest since before the Norman Conquest, it remained a protected hunting ground as well as a site for coal-mining and ironworks from Roman times to the Industrial Revolution.

Now, the combination of secretive forests, rolling farmland and ridges above the Wye gorge and the Severn Vale provide excellent paths and spectacular views. With detailed route descriptions and information on access, accommodation and historical points of interest, this guidebook is the ideal companion to exploring everything this ancient Forest has to offer.

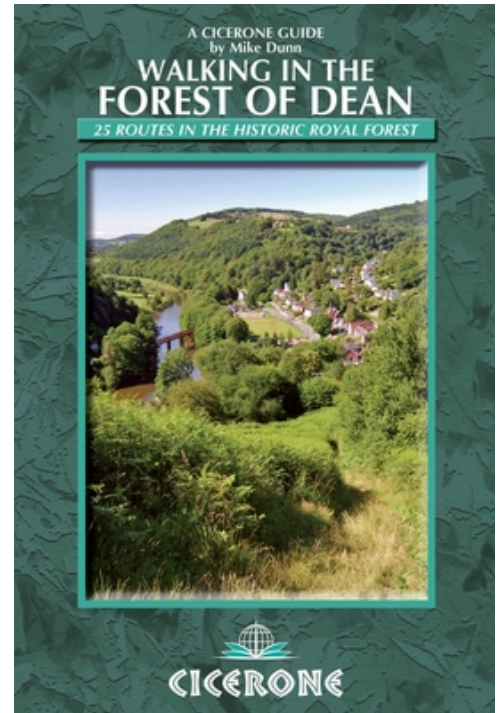
