With 80 routes, this guide offers walkers many opportunities to explore the 'Jolly Green Giants' of Highland Perthshire. Bound by the Cairngorms to the north, Stirling to the south and stretching to Bridge of Orchy in the west, the guide's graded routes include all 42 Munros in the region. In addition, the guide covers 22 selected Corbetts, 15 smaller (but notable) hills, the low-level routes in the 'Big tree Country' and the historic passes of Gaick and Minigaig.

The long grass slopes and peaty cols provide a wealth of walking opportunities, the nature of the landscape resulting in heather and pebble-strewn plateaux and rounded ridges, with a break from the scrambling other Scottish ranges require. Perthshire's broad mountain tops, ancient woodland and ribbons of lochs hold wide scope for exploration and remote hiking, as well as lower river-side ambles, and all with a promise of tea and shortbread at the end.

This guide provides walkers with the best, and often most unconventional, routes to the mountains of the region. With PVC cover, detailed route descriptions, clear maps, photography and invaluable advice, the guide is the perfect companion to explore Perthshire's hills.



