Mount Kailash, hidden behind the Himalayas in Tibet, is a mysterious mountain 6714m (22,028ft) high. It has for more than a thousand years been a pilgrimage site for some of the world's major religions. It is sacred to Hindus, Buddhists, Bonpo and Jains from India.

The guide provides essential planning information for the trip, including travel into and within Tibet. It guides the trekker on the journey round the sacred peak. The highest point is the Drolma La, the pass of the goddess Tara.

About the author


