This is the second edition of this excellent trail following the Tees from its source near Dufton in the Cumbrian Pennines through the north-east countryside to the North Sea near Teeside.

The 100 miles of the route are described in eight stages, with excellent walking in varied country passing through wild moorland and deep dales, many with dramatic waterfalls, through gentle pastures and industrial towns. Illustrated with OS maps and colour photographs, the guide includes all the information, such as accommodation, necessary to complete the route.

This guide also includes a selection of 10 circular walks based on and around the route.


