**Follow the paths of old-time forest rangers from Ahon-nokka to the magnificent Kynnäränharju esker that divides Lake Liesjärvi and enjoy the landscapes of Häme at their best. In summer, you can travel back in time on Korteniemi Heritage Farm. Take part in farmhouse chores, admire the sheep or lie down in a hay field, relax and watch the clouds drift by.**

### Valuable nature and versatile services

Liesjärvi National Park is a realm of sturdy spruce forests, light-filled lingonberry heaths, eskers and stunning lake landscapes. Lake Liesjärvi, from which the National Park derives its name, is not part of the actual park but its lush shoreline forests and beautiful islands add significantly to the natural values of the area. The top attractions are Kynnäränharju esker, Ahon-nokka old-growth forest and Korteniemi Heritage Farm.

In Liesjärvi, hikers can enjoy the park's versatile services. The campfire sites of the park, or Peukaloisen lean-to shelter, Kaksvetinen hut and Savilahti camping area, can be used freely by all hikers. The accessible cooking shelter of Tittilampi and two charming huts, Peukaloisen and Hyypio, can be reserved.

The National Park has around 30 kilometres of trails, which are part of Hämeen Ilvesreitti trail

network. The circle trails of Pohjantikka (5 km) and Punatulkku (3.1 km) as well as Ahon-nokka nature trail (1.3 km) start behind the threshing shed of Korteniemi Heritage Farm. The accessible Peukaloisen polku trail (4 km) starts from Peukalolamminkangas (4 km). Circle trails can also be found in other parts of the park. Along the trails hikers can enjoy the diverse nature of the National Park. Lake Liesjärvi's sandy shores invite you to swim, and in the autumn you can find berries and fungi in the forest.

### Korteniemi Heritage Farm

Korteniemi Heritage Farm is located in the southern corner of the National Park. The surroundings of the old forest ranger's farm bring you back to

times past. The farm buildings have stood in their places for more than a hundred years. A rooster struts in the farmyard with his hens, and cows and sheep graze in the meadows. In summer, you can take part in events, guided tours or farm work in 1910s style. The old smoke sauna is large enough for even a bigger group to relax in its gentle heat. While access to the farm is free, a fee is charged for guided tours and bathing in the smoke sauna, and these services must be booked in advance.

### Responsible hiking

By complying with the park rules and outdoor etiquette, you show respect for nature and your fellow hikers as well as ensure that the park's natural values are preserved. The outdoor etiquette has the basics of outdoor recreation and responsible hiking in a nutshell.



### Enjoy the outdoors while protecting nature

- Visitors are allowed to walk, ski, row and paddle in the park, except in certain restricted areas (see map).
- Cycling and horseback riding are only allowed on the designated trails.
- Short-term camping is allowed in the camping area and at the lean-to shelter and hut.
- Campfires are only permitted at designated sites. When a forest or grass fire warning has been issued, fires are only permitted in fireplaces with flues, which can be found at Tittilampi reservable cooking shelter and in Kaksvetinen hut.
- You may pick berries and edible mushrooms, but do not collect rocks or plants. Please do not disturb the wildlife.
- The water areas are not part of the National Park. You can fish with a rod and line, and through a hole in the ice in winter under everyone's rights. The Fishing Act must be complied with. ([www.kalat.fi](http://www.kalat.fi), [www.kalastusrajoitus.fi](http://www.kalastusrajoitus.fi))
- Follow the rules of litter-free hiking. Please take all wastes away when you leave.
- Please note that toilets are not equipped with toilet paper.
- Pets must be kept on a leash.
