The walks take in plenty of interesting historical sites as well as formidable castles and churches. There are also many museums and attractions to visit along the way.

Walking is generally easy, though short walks can be joined together to create longer challenges, such as the Jersey Coastal Walk, and the Channel Islands Way.

Famous for its sunshine, history and wonderful coastline, Jersey is an intriguing destination for travellers. Outwardly British but with French overtones, it is a compact island often busy with visitors - who have a lot to fit in if they want to experience everything the island has to offer.



